Dear Parents and Nursery Helpers,

Thank you for your willingness to serve your church family by watching the children in the nursery. Attached is our schedule for 2018.

If you are unable to serve on your designated Sunday, please be considerate and find a substitute to fill in for you. You can either switch with someone, or call me to get a list of subs. Once you have your time covered, please call me to let me know who will be serving in the nursery. There is a copy for everyone who is on the schedule here. You can also find the schedule posted in the nursery, in the messenger (one month in advance), in the bulletin (one week in advance), and online on our church's website. **You will notice the schedule is a bit different this year. There have been many Sundays where there are no kids in the nursery and when there are kids in there, it is usually 4 or 5 max. So, I have put only one worker in there for most Sundays. The couples that have nursery aged children, I have included both parents on the schedule, please use your discretion here.**

I just wanted to remind you of the procedures of the nursery. In order to make the morning easier for our parents and to try and keep our children healthy, the following should be followed. Please do your best to follow these guidelines.

- \* The church will provide all diapers and wipes. They are located in the drawers in the changing table.
- \* Parents are to only bring a labeled bottle in with their child/baby when dropping them off. Please NO snacks.
- \* Please do your best to put all toys back with their respective parts and in their proper places.
- \* There is a yellow bucket on top of the bookshelves and we are asking that you put all toys that have been put in children's mouths, spit on, chewed on, coughed on, and sneezed on in the yellow bucket at the end of the nursery hour. These items will be disinfected before the next Sunday.
- \* Also, please take note of the "Dutch" door that has been installed. The idea behind the door is to provide added safety and security for the little ones in the nursery. Please keep the bottom half closed and locked and greet parents at the door when they arrive to drop off their child. The top half is to be used as a pass-through when dropping children off. That way if children are playing on the other side, they are not getting hit by the opening of the door. Also, for children that may be having a hard time adjusting, this provides a visual barrier between them and the hallway where parents may be waiting/standing. It will also hopefully prevent any little ones from escaping! Please use your judgement when using the "Dutch" door system based on the individual child's situation.
